What is the Inverness Piercing System?

The Inverness Ear Piercing System includes:

- Our hand-pressured piercing instrument
- A surgical marking pen to make placement dots
- Pre-sterilized hypoallergenic piercing earrings aftercare solution for the care of newly-pierced ears
- Aftercare solution for the care of newly-pierced ears

What sets Inverness apart?

The Inverness Ear Piercing System has two safety features that set Inverness apart from other piercing systems:

Number 1:

Only Inverness has fully-enclosed sterile earring capsules that prevent the piercing earring from being exposed to possible contaminants prior to piercing.



Number 2:

Only Inverness Piercing Earrings have our exclusive Inverness Safety Back™ to shield the sharp piercing tip and prevent the earring back from being squeezed too tight while the piercing heals.



How does the Inverness Piercing System work?

The Inverness System is designed to pierce ears in 3 easy steps:

Step 1: Cleanse



Step 2: Mark



Step 3: Pierce



- Inverness piercing earrings have ultra-thin posts with an extra sharp tip that acts as a gentle needle to perform the piercing.
- The pre-sterilized piercing earring is designed to push through the ear easily using only hand pressure from our specially-designed piercing instrument.
- When the instrument handle is fully depressed, the earring post pierces the ear and connects with our Safety Back™ in one smooth quiet motion.



Ear Piercing Policy

Piercing is available for any customer as determined by your store's age requirement.

All minors must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian who will sign the ear piercing release authorization form and be present during the piercing.

Inverness is used to pierce earlobes and the outer cartilage only.

Only fully trained associates should perform an ear piercing.
